

evacuated to the city of Kyiv.


Irpin City, Kyiv Region, 12.03.2022

Chernihiv City, 10.04.2022



Evacuation of civilians from Irpin, through a bridge destroyed by shelling. The bridge was destroyed by the Armed Forces of Ukraine to prevent the enemy from reaching Kyiv. On this day at 10 am women, children and the elderly were supposed to be evacuated from the town by trains, but the enemy blew up the railroad tracks so people were asked to move to another location from where they would be picked up by buses for transportation to Kyiv railway station.
